To Apply for Admission

See our website at www.nsc.nevada.edu for academic requirements. Submit an application online, through the mail, or in person, there is a nonrefundable \$30 application processing fee due upon submission of the undergraduate application. Nevada State College must receive official transcripts from each high school and/or college you attended to complete your application.

The Nevada State College online application is available at www.nsc.nevada.edu. You can complete the application for undergraduate admission safely and securely over the internet. The online application can be completed in as little as 10 minutes. Alternately, paper applications may be picked up at the Office of Admissions & Records.

Equal consideration is given to applicants using either of the options listed. We encourage you to consider electronic submission because it facilitates greater communication between our office and you.

NOTE: The Office of Admissions & Records strongly suggests that students complete the application by August 1st with official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended to allow sufficient processing time.

New First Year Students

Complete the entire application for admission. Return the application, along with your official transcripts, to the Office of Admissions & Records. Check your application status at anytime through your online student account. Visit www.nsc.nevada.edu; click 'Student Account;' and follow the instructions.

Transfer Students

Complete the application for admission. Return the application, along with official transcripts, to the Office of Admission & Orientation. Students with less than 12 credits from an accredited college must also submit official high school transcripts.

Check your application status at anytime through your online student account. Visit www.nsc.nevada.edu; click 'Student Account;' and follow the instructions.

Non-Degree Student

An individual who does not intend to seek a degree with Nevada State College is defined as a non-degree student. This does not include students who have been admitted as undecided majors.

A non-degree student may register for a maximum of fifteen semester credits of classroom instruction in one semester. Although there is no limit to the number of credits that may be earned as a non-degree student, a maximum of 32 semester credits is accepted towards a baccalaureate degree. Non-degree students are not eligible for advising or financial aid, including student loans.

Newly Admitted Students

1. Make an appointment with your academic advisor prior to registration. Call 992-2160 to contact the advisor.
2. Take Placement Exams if:
 - a. you are entering as a freshmen and have not taken the ACT or SAT exams or transferred College Level English or Mathematics (ie AP Test).
 - b. you are a transfer student, (i.e., transferring in 12 or more semester credits), but you are not transferring in English or Mathematics courses and do not have the necessary ACT or SAT scores.

If you have taken the ACT or SAT exams you must submit official test scores to the Office of Admissions & Records. The school code is 4572 for the SAT exam and 2486 for the ACT exam.

Registration Information

Registration for Spring 2011 will be divided by the number of credit hours earned.

Deferred Payment – Fees

You may choose a deferred payment plan if you are registered for three credits or more. To enroll in this plan, go to your student account and select 'Deferred Payment Option', then click accept.

- The first installment (25 percent) of your per-credit registration fee, nonresident tuition (if applicable), and special fees are due by December 30, 2011.
- The next installment (25 percent) is due February 15, 2011 (no bill will be sent).
- The last installment (25 percent) is due March 15, 2011 (no bill will be sent).
- The last installment (25 percent) is due April 11, 2011 (no bill will be sent).

According to Board of Regents Handbook, Title 4, Chapter 17, Section 15.e, "A penalty of 10 percent with a minimum of \$10 shall be charged on the deferred payment not paid by the due date."

Nevada State College Code of Conduct and Ethics

Nevada State College is committed to fostering and supporting an orderly and respectful learning environment for all members of the campus community. As students participate in the campus community and its sponsored activities, they are responsible for their own actions and subject to local, state and national laws, as well as all Nevada System of Higher Education and college regulations.

Students charged with violations of system or college regulations may be subject to disciplinary action. The procedures for carrying out student discipline are based on those procedures established by the Nevada System of Higher Education, found in Chapter 6 of the Board of Regents Code. These procedures exist to ensure due process and to support the rights of all students on campus. It is the belief of the college that the judicial proceedings should have an educational outcome, while accomplishing the goal of resolution of the problematic behavior.

Disability Resources

At Nevada State College, we recognize and embrace our responsibility to provide equal access to educational programs and services to all qualified persons with documented disabilities, as mandated under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

A student requesting accommodations is responsible for providing appropriate and current medical documentation of his/her qualifying disability. Students with disabilities should contact the Resource Center for Students with Disabilities (RCSD) at 992-2180 (voice) or through e-mail at nsc.rcsd@nsc.nevada.edu to initiate services, as soon as possible after making the decision to enroll.

Financial Aid and Scholarship Information

Your tuition and fee bill will not reflect any aid awarded to you as it is printed before federal regulations allow funds to be transferred to your student account to pay outstanding financial obligations. Financial aid, including scholarships, will begin to be disbursed to your tuition and fee bill one week before the first day of class. Once your account balance is paid in full, any remaining funds will be mailed to you using the address on your student account. You can confirm your address by visiting your online student registration account. If your student account reflects the wrong address, please make any changes online or contact the NSC Office of the Registrar. If the amount of aid that is applied to your tuition and fee bill is less than what you owe, you must pay the balance by the posted payment due date.

If you have accepted financial aid and it appears the funds will not pay your tuition and fees by the posted payment due date or if you have not been awarded financial aid, you will need to make payment arrangements by using the NSC Deferred Payment option available online through the registration site.

To ensure your financial aid is disbursed before the tuition and fee payment due date, all of the following requirements must be met:

1. New Fall Financial Aid applicants: complete the *FAFSA* by March 1, 2010 and respond to any additional inquiries from NSC Student Financial Services.
2. Register for the appropriate level of credits for which your aid was approved at least 2 weeks before classes begin. (Full-time = 12 or more credits, Three-quarter time = 9 - 11 credits, Half-time = 6 - 8 credits, and Less-than-half-time = 1 - 5 credits)
3. Contact NSC Student Financial Services and Scholarships if you enroll in more or less credits than indicated on your award notification no later than January 8, 2010. This will allow adjustments to your financial aid to be completed before classes begin. If your enrollment level changes you must contact NSC SFSS immediately.
4. You have met all Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements for any previous NSC enrollment. Visit the NSC website at www.nsc.nevada.edu/finaid for details or contact NSC Student Financial Services and Scholarships.
5. Federal Stafford/Parent Loan recipients: 1) Submit your complete loan activation form to Student Financial Services before January 8, 2010, 2) Complete the master promissory note online (if you have not done so during a previous semester at NSC) at least 3 weeks before courses begin, and 3) First time student borrowers must complete online entrance counseling at least 2 weeks before classes begin.
6. Outside Agency Scholarship recipients: Confirm with your donor or the appropriate agency that your funds will be mailed to NSC Student Financial Services and Scholarships by January 8, 2010.

Institutional Refund Policy – Financial Aid Recipients

If you drop credits and receive a 100% refund, your aid will be adjusted if your enrollment level has changed. All refunds will be applied back to the financial aid programs you were awarded and if there are remaining funds you will receive the remaining balance by check. When enrollment levels change you may have to repay funds if it is determined you were awarded more funds than you were eligible to receive. If you consider dropping a course, please speak with NSC Student Financial Services and Scholarships to determine how this will affect your current and future aid eligibility. You are also advised to seek academic advising before dropping courses to ensure you remain on track for your degree program.

Return of Financial Aid Funds

If you withdraw from all courses and receive a 100% refund you will be required to repay all financial aid funds you received back to NSC. All financial aid paid on your behalf will be returned to the appropriate financial account. If you received a refund you will be required to repay the outstanding balance to NSC upon notification.

If you completely withdraw from courses you may be required to repay a portion of your financial aid to NSC and/or the U.S. Department of Education, regardless of when you drop your courses and the amount of refund (100%, 50%, or 0%). Nevada State College is required to perform a prorated calculation to determine how much of the aid you were eligible to receive based on your attendance. If repayment of financial aid funds will be necessary, you will be notified and you may not be eligible for future aid at any institution until the funds are repaid. Remember to seek advising from NSC Student Financial Services and Scholarships and your academic advisor before you opt to drop courses.
